1. Conference location

Météo-France - Meteopole - Conference International Centre (hereafter referred to as "CIC")
42 avenue Gaspard Coriolis, 31057 Toulouse Cedex, France

2. Admittance to the Meteopole and the conference

Admission to the conference is pending on finalizing registration and payment. A banking machine (Visa, Mastercard, AE) is available in the hall of the restaurant of the Météopole, and credit card payment is also possible. You will receive a badge and lunch tickets.

According to Météo-France security rules, you must wear your conference badge permanently during the conference. If you enter Météo-France in way other than the conference shuttle service, you will have to go through the security checks and show or deposit an ID card.

The airport shuttle is called "**Aerocar**"

last departure from airport : 00.15 a.m.

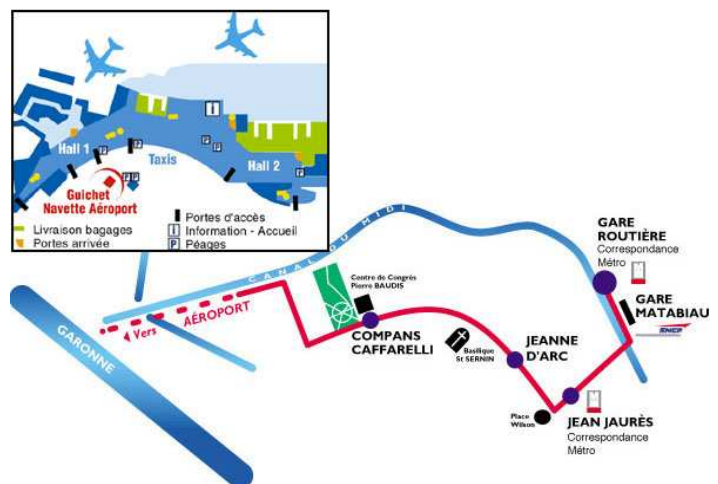
Stopping places :

1- "Compans"

2- "Place Jeanne d'Arc", for Anatole France, Athénée, Ibis Centre, Mermoz, Raymond IV, St Sernin, Trianon

3- "Allées Jean-Jaurès", for Underground and for hotels Albert 1^{er}, Crown Plaza, Castellane, Holiday Inn Toulouse Centre Capoul, de France, Citadines Wilson, Grand hotel de l'Opera, Mercure St Georges, Mercure Wilson, Ours Blanc, du Taur, Royal Wilson

4- "Gare Matabiau", for Underground and for hotels Terminus, Phoenicia, Citea hotel , Riquet



→ **from the airport to Météo-France**

A taxi can drive you to Météopole in about 15 minutes.

It should cost around 20 €.

You can also take the airport shuttle to the stop

"Allées Jean-Jaurès", and then the underground and bus (see below).

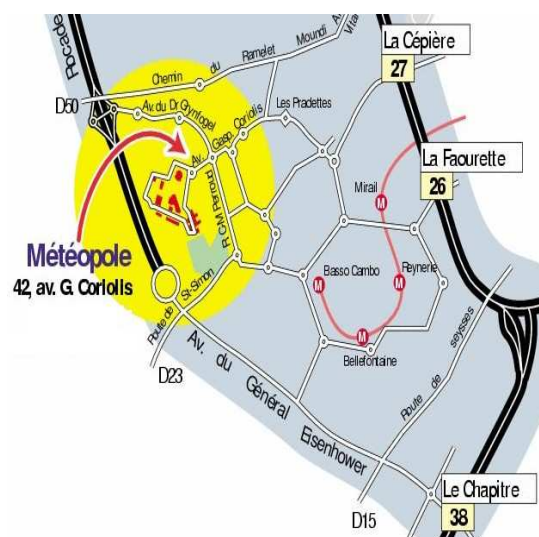
→ **from the centre of Toulouse to Météo-France**

Take the underground to the last stop "Basso Cambo", then

catch a bus on line number 8 , Check that the direction at the front of the bus is "Lycée Polyvalent", then get off at stop

"Météo-France". Alternatively, bus 21 heading to "Colomiers Airbus" stops close to Météo-France, at bus stop "Vandel"

An underground + bus ticket costs around 1,25 €.
