### **Work Plan**

Papers submitted to Tellus by authors (see short instructions to authors Annex 1) will be submitted in the online process as "MOZAIC—IAGOS 20th Anniversary Symposium". Guest editors will be given read-only access. This means they can see all that the editors see except they cannot correspond directly online with the authors (that is responsibility of the editors). When a paper is submitted, the quest editors receive a notification. Then the following steps will take place:

- 1. Using the online tools, <u>the guest editors</u> will screen the papers for quality and recommend acceptance for review or not. If yes, they will recommend reviewers to the editors taking into account the suggestions by the authors as well as their own.
- 2. The <u>editors</u> will manage appointment of two reviewers using the normal online system. Once they accept, reviewers have one month to submit reviews and are prompted automatically by the system.
- 3. The guest editors will read the reviews online and recommend to the editors a decision.
- 4. The Editors will respond appropriately to the author.
- 5. Steps 3 and 4 will be repeated until acceptance or rejection.
- 6. Papers will be immediately published as regular Tellus papers AND viewable in the Special Issues section of Tellus online under the full name of the Special Issue (see above)


