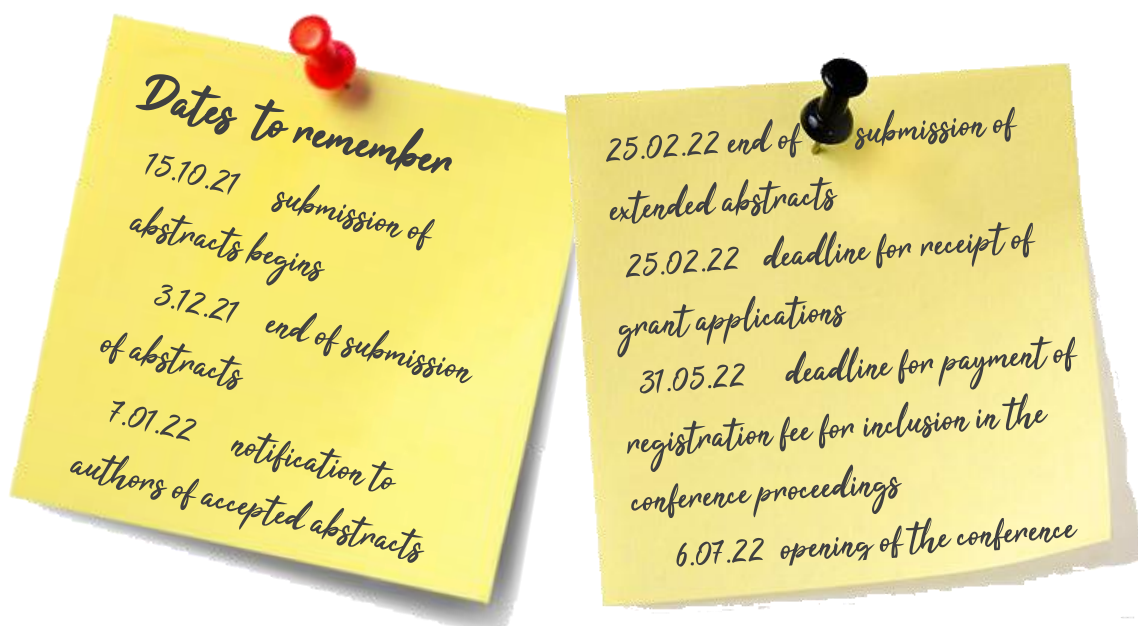


**First announcement and call for papers**

## Climate change, risks and adaptation.

The 35th annual AIC conference, jointly organised by Météo-France and the University of Toulouse III, will take place in Toulouse from 6 to 9 July 2022. It will be held at the Centre International de Conférences of Météo France. On Saturday 9 July, a scientific excursion will take place at the Pic du Midi Observatory (2880m). In the context of the multiplication of extreme events linked to climate change and the definition of adaptation measures at the different scales relevant for decision-making, the general theme of the conference will be *Climate change, risks and adaptation*. Other classical sub-themes of the disciplines of climatology are also proposed.

## ► Oral presentations or poster

The conference will be held in person. Presentations will be in the form of an oral presentation (15 min plus 5 min discussion) or a poster (A0 format, portrait orientation).

## ► Official languages of the conference

French and English

## ► Submission of abstracts

Authors must register and submit the abstract of their oral or poster communication (2500 characters maximum) on the conference website before December 3, 2021

Participants may present only one paper as first author.

## ► Selection, review and publication

After notification to the authors of the accepted abstracts (January 7, 2022), the first author will have to submit the extended abstract\* (4 to 6 pages maximum) before February 25, 2022, which will be submitted to a review process by the scientific committee.

The final text must be validated by the scientific committee and will only be published in the conference proceedings once the first author has paid the registration fee.
