DEEP CONVECTION ASSOCIATED TO EX-BERGUITTA IS VERY LIMITED. THE MAXIMUM WINDS ARE ESTIMATED AT 40KT FAR FROM THE CENTER.

THE RAPID SOUTHERN TRACK WILL SLOW INTO THE EVENING, STOPPED BY A LOW/MID LEVEL RIDGE MOVING SOUTH OF THE SYSTEM. NEXT, EX-BERGUITTA IS EXPECTED TO LEAVE TROPICAL LATITUDES, SOUTH-EASTWARDS, DRIVEN BY THE PASSAGE OF A TROUGH AT SOUTH-EAST.
